



**Urso's Princess Jasmine CDX, ASCA-CD, RE,  
CGC**

**and K-9 Immunity for Cancer**

As a member of the Birmingham Obedience Training Club, Jasmine (my boxer) and I train for AKC competition events in obedience and rally. She has earned multiple titles in both venues and placements each time with the exception of two shows.

Jasmine is my pride and joy. Like most dogs, she has gone through some health problems. At 9 months old she came into her first heat cycle and never recovered, developing endometriosis and pyometra and became very sick and was spayed. She went on to earn her CD, CDX, and RE title with a breeze and then became sick and developed mass cell tumors grades two and three. The first two tumors were removed surgically and the veterinarian said "if she gets through the next 9 months without the tumors returning, she may not get any more". But the dreaded tumors returned 7 months later, only to have to put Jasmine through another surgery to remove them, this time in the hock area of which the stitches would not hold because of lack of elasticity of the skin in that area. She was put under anesthesia again, to attempt the re-stitching of the wounds and they failed to hold a second time and a long recuperation time followed. The incisions remained open and had to heal and scar over by themselves. Multiple vets told me this type of cancer is usually recurring and once it moved into the lymph nodes and/or the organs such as the kidney, stomach, liver it was downhill from there. I began researching every possible aspect, determined to find an alternative to chemo, radiation and surgery. I was determined that my beautiful girl was going to live longer than 4 years of age.

Out of the competition ring for more than a year and a half, with the exception of one show in Memphis, TN, I was going to retire Jasmine and let her live out whatever time she had left as best as possible. But she loves to train. So I started training her for the Utility ring. We'd have good days and bad, but I was still on a mission to find a cure. Then she developed another dreaded tumor on her inner left thigh more than 1/2 the size of your palm. It was the largest tumor yet and she wasn't feeling good at all. And then with the help of my cousin, we discovered K-9 Immunity and Transfactor.

I did my research on the product and the site is very informative. I switched her to a NO-GRAIN diet, "Taste of the Wild" and immediately started her on the K-9 Immunity and Transfactor. The site said one would see a difference in the tumor within 10 days, and I did. The cancer or mass inside seemed to be shrinking. I watched over the next 3 months and by the 4th month, all the matter inside the tumor was gone, all she has now is a small darkened area where the tumor was.

Jasmine is still on K-9 Immunity and so far is cancer free. She still has days when I can tell she may not feel 100%, but she bounces right back the next day. The K-9 Immunity and Transfactor is expensive, but to me it is cheaper than chemo and so much better on the dog.

Jasmine still has some "not-so-good" days, but overall she is so much better than before. The K-9 Immunity also helps build a dog's immune system.

Today, Jasmine continues to train for Utility, hopefully by this fall she'll be ready. For the most part, her puppy-like ways have returned and her energy levels are higher.

I'm proud of her accomplishments, but more than that I love her and happily celebrated her 6th birthday on July 5, 2009.

K-9 Immunity saved her life and a beautiful life it is. The vet asked what happened to the tumor and I told him about K-9 Immunity.
